What your gift will support

Whilst you are welcome to leave a gift for a specific area of our work, we encourage you to include the words 'general purposes' to allow Norfolk & Norwich Festival to adapt its delivery should a project or activity no longer be running.

How to include a gift to Norfolk & Norwich Festival

If you have already made a Will, a codicil is a supplement that alters or adds to an existing Will. You can download a codicil form here [\[link\]](#). Please keep your codicil with your Will, in a safe place.

If you are making a new Will, we recommend you seek professional advice from a Solicitor. There is some helpful advice about Wills and leaving a gift from Remember A Charity.

Unless a different wish is expressed, all legacy gifts to Norfolk & Norwich Festival are directed into a dedicated legacy fund - **The Festival Future Fund** - a long-term resource designed to provide annual funds to develop our annual Festival, our work with artists, children, young people and their communities and support organisational running costs.

A gift to a charity, such as the Festival, will potentially reduce the amount of inheritance tax due on your estate.
